After graduating from the Faculty of Economics at the University of Belgrade in 1995, Dragijana Radonjić Petrović began her professional career as a broker at the Belgrade Discount Center. In 1997, she joined the brokerage firm M&V Investments, where she was soon appointed General Manager and, through her dedication, led the company to a leading position in the domestic financial market.

From April 2010 to August 2012, she served as State Secretary at the Ministry of Economy and Regional Development of the Republic of Serbia, responsible for regional development and entrepreneurship, as well as for the coordination of EU IPA projects and bilateral international assistance projects within the Ministry's competence, with a total value of nearly EUR 150 million.

In August 2012, she was appointed Special Advisor to the Minister at the Ministry of Finance and Economy, responsible for entrepreneurship and competitiveness. She initiated the preparation of programs and legislation to strengthen these areas. She coordinated a team of experts that successfully organized the last three issuances of government Eurobonds. She was also appointed National Authorising Officer, and in this role significantly improved the process of establishing a system for the decentralized management of EU pre-accession funds.

Since May 2014, she has been the founder and partner of the consulting firm MD Solution d.o.o.

Ms. Petrović is highly committed to the development of the economics profession and to social engagement. She is a member of the Executive Board of the Association of Business Women of Serbia, Vice President of the Serbian Economists Association, and a member of the Executive Board of the Business Club "Privrednik" and the Serbian Association of Corporate Directors.

She is a member of the Board of Directors of Messer Tehnogas A.D. Belgrade and a member of the Supervisory Board of Uniqa Life Insurance a.d.o.

In December 2017, she was appointed Honorary Consul of the Republic of the Philippines in the Republic of Serbia.
